ABOUT

Extended Opportunity Program and Services (EOPS) is a state funded support program designed to encourage and support the successful enrollment, retention, graduation, and transfer of students affected by economic, social, and educational disadvantages. EOPS support services are designed to assist eligible students in successfully completing their educational and career goals. The program offers academic, personal, and career counseling, financial resources, and other support services that go “over and above” the traditional services offered at the college. EOPS and eligible students enter into a mutual agreement and partnership where the program will make available to you a number of support services such as priority registration, professional counseling, individualized tutoring, textbook assistance and much more. Students mutually agree to make academic progress and meet other requirements of the program, which are designed with the student’s success in mind.

HIGHLIGHTS

LACC EOPS is one of the largest EOPS programs in the California Community College system serving approximately 2400 students (unduplicated) in the 2018-2019 academic year.

FACILITIES

- EOPS shares a student computer lab and tutoring space with TRIO SSS and CalWORKs
- Computer Loan Program for CARE and NextUp Students
- CARE and NextUp students can receive unmet financial need grants

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WHAT DOES EOPS OFFER?

- Priority registration - register for classes early!
- Academic, personal, and career counseling
- Book voucher services
- School supplies (as a new EOPS student)

- University Transfer Assistance such as field trips, tours, university application fee waivers and transfer advising
- **CARE Program**- additional supplemental services above EOPS services for students who are single parents, with at least one child under the age of 18 and participating in GAIN/CalWORKs
- **NextUp Program** (in partnership with Guardian Scholars) additional services above EOPS services to support the health and well being of students who are former foster youth
- Achievement Ceremony to celebrate all EOPS students who complete certificates, associates degrees and/or transfer to a four-year university
- EOPS provides supplemental weekly meal assistance
