



What is CARE?

CARE Program is an extension of EOPS for single parents/heads of household receiving TANF/CalWORKs who are pursuing their educational goals.

What services does CARE provide?

- CARE Counselor/Coordinator and support staff
- Academic, Personal and Retention, Counseling
- Priority Appointment with CARE Counselor
 - Empowerment Sessions
 - Educational Workshops
- University and Cultural field trips
 - School supply kit
- Student parking permit
 - *(With proper verification)*
 - ASG Benefits
 - Auto Gas Cards
 - *(During workshops & if funding permits)*
 - Meal Credit
 - Laptop Loan Program
 - *(Limited availability on first come first serve basis)*
 - Bus Tokens
 - *(Issued only to students w/o a parking permit)*



How do I qualify?

- ✓ Acceptance into the EOPS Program
- ✓ Be a Single head of household
- ✓ Be officially approved for TANF/CalWORKs
- ✓ Have at least one child under the age of 18
- ✓ Be at least 18 years of age
- ✓ Attend an In Person CARE Consultation
