



Information Sheet

EOP&S provides support services to non-traditional students affected by educational and economic barriers. It motivates students toward career goals and fosters self-esteem. EOP&S at City College is the largest state-funded program of its type in California.

Program Qualifications:

1. You must be a full time student (12 units or more).
*If you are a **Disabled Student Program and Services (DSPS) member**, you must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 units to apply. Your registration fee receipt must be stamped at the **DSPS office**.*
2. You must be a California Resident.
3. Not have a total of 69 degree applicable units completed in any community college or four year university.
Must not have a confirmed Associate of Arts/Science degree or higher.
4. Have been approved for a Board of Governor's A or B Fee Waiver for the current semester.
5. Be educationally disadvantaged according to state regulations.

Program Services:

1. Academic and personal counseling.
2. Assistance with books.
*New students are not guaranteed a book voucher for the current semester.
New students will be eligible the following semester if they comply with program regulations.*
3. Priority Registration.
4. Tutoring.
5. Assistance with scholarships, resumes, study and note-taking techniques, educational workshops and field trips.
6. Transfer assistance and **UC and CSU** application fee-waivers.

Admission Procedures:

1. Present your original registration fee receipt showing enrollment in **12 units or more (DSPS 6 units or more.)** Fill out an **EOP&S** application.

To make this process easier, please bring the following documents with you:

- a: **Math and English Assessment test scores.**
- b: **Official or unofficial copy of your transcripts from previous colleges or universities attended.**

2. It usually takes 48 hours (2 days) to process your application. However, at the beginning of the semester, when we are extremely busy, it can take up to 3 days.
3. Return to the office after the indicated period of time to find out if you qualify.
4. If you qualify, you will need to attend an orientation session.
(The 1½ hour orientation is designed to explain the program's services and to review and sign the Mutual Responsibility Contract).

THIS ORIENTATION IS MANDATORY TO ENTER THE PROGRAM.
