Dealing with Meltdowns and Tantrums (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	April 9, 2024 5:30pm-8:30pm	Denetra Norwood	Many children have temper tantrums and meltdowns. Is there a difference? What are the causes? What should a parent do when this happens? In this class we will look at the difference between a temper tantrum and a meltdown. We will also discuss the causes, how to understand them, and how to manage them.
Special Education and the IEP (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	April 12, 2024 6:00pm-9:00pm	Sharonda Barksdale	Come to learn all about IEPs: what it is, how to request one from the school, understanding IEP goals and plan, advocate for your child's education. This workshop is to teach parents the importance of having an IEP for your child and the steps to take to make sure you get the necessary help needed for services.
Special Care Increment (SCI) Training (Formerly known as D & F- rate training)	April 15, 16, 17 2024, 5pm-9pm **YOU MUST ATTEND ALL THREE SESSIONS**	Sandra Smith	The Special Care Increment (SCI)Training is the 12 hours foundational training (which replaces the D & F rate pre-service training) for resource parents who are caring for children, adolescents and non-minor dependents who require specialized care resulting in resource parents going above and beyond the basic level of care (LOC) to meet a child's health, physical, emotional, behavioral, educational, permanency and family service needs. This training covers an overview and explanation of LOC & SCI, substance use, medication and behavior management, the impact of trauma on development, navigating the educational system, birth parent engagement, self-care and resources for successful SCI placement.
Turning Dreams into Degrees: Higher Education Module 2 (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	April 19, 2024 6:00pm-9:00pm	Sharonda Barksdale	The purpose of this module is to empower caregivers to discuss the value of higher education with their youth and provide ideas for how they can play an active role in supporting their youth to college. For caregivers with youth in high school college can seem so far into the future that it can take secondary importance to more immediate concerns. Caregivers will learn the significance of early college exploration and preparation and key steps that they can take to help youth turn their dreams into degrees
Teens and Responsible Phone Use (Renewal for RFA, W, and SCI-Specialized)	April 22, 2024 5:30pm-8:30pm	Sandra Smith	This workshop will address the importance of teaching responsible online activity. We will learn about the dangers of sexting. We will talk about the most popular social media applications used by youth, and the risk of posting information online.
