## ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE IN PARALEGAL STUDIES

## WHAT ARE THE COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PARALEGAL PROGRAM AT LOS ANGELES CITY COLLEGE?

The Associates in Arts Degree in Paralegal Studies consists of classes totaling 64 semester units:

1. A minimum of 43 semester units of required classes, 18 of which are designated as "legal specialty - required courses." A legal specialty course is a course that (1) covers substantive law or legal procedures or process, (2) has been developed for paralegals, and (3) emphasizes practical paralegal skills.
2. A minimum of 21 semester units of General Education (Plan B).

Competency Requirement:
Students must demonstrate competence in reading, in written expression, and in mathematics. The following courses are approved to meet the competency requirement for the Associate Degree as defined in Board Rule 6201.12.

## A. Reading and Written Expression

1. Competence in Reading and Written Expression shall be demonstrated by achieving a grade of "C" or better in English 101 or its equivalent at another college.

## B. Mathematics

1. Competence in Mathematics shall be demonstrated by achieving a grade of "C" or better in Math $\mathbf{1 2 5}$ or Math 124A and Math 124B or higher or its equivalent at another college.

A student who has earned an A.A. degree or higher from an accredited post-secondary institution, must have their transcripts evaluated to determine if some or all of their general education course work meets the requirements for an A.A. Degree in Paralegal Studies at Los Angeles City College.

The following is a list of the 43 semester units of required classes. The courses are arranged in a suggested, not mandatory, course sequence.:

3 semester units (Required) Offered every semester.

## $\square$ Law 14, Law Office Management

3 semester units (Required) Offered every semester.

## $\square$ Law 19, Property and Creditor's Rights

3 semester units (Required) Offered during the Spring Semester.

## THIRD SEMESTER

## $\square$ Law 2, Business Law II

3 semester units (Required) Offered every semester.

## $\square$ Law 11, Introduction to Legal Assistant II

3 semester units (Legal Specialty - Required) Offered during the Fall Semester. Prerequisites: Law 10

## $\square$ Law 12, Tort Law and Claims Investigation

3 semester units (Legal Specialty - Required) Offered during the Fall Semester. Prerequisites: Law 10

Paralegal Elective, 3 semester units (Elective) (See electives list below)

## FOURTH SEMESTER

Law 4, Directed Field Work in Legal Assisting
3 semester units (Legal Specialty - Required) Offered during the Spring Semester. Prerequisites: Law 10

## Law 17, Legal Writing

3 semester units (Legal Specialty - Required) Offered during the Spring Semester. Prerequisites: Law 10 and English 101Law 51, Legal Research for Paralegals
3 semester units (Legal Specialty - Required) Offered during the Spring Semester. Prerequisites: Law 10Paralegal Elective, 3 semester units (Elective) (See electives list below)

ELECTIVES (You need two electives.)Law 3, Civil Rights and the Law (Elective) Offered every semester.Law 7, Street Law (Elective) Offered during the Fall Semester.Law 13, Wills, Trusts, and Probate Admin. (Elective) Offered occasionally.Law 18, Marriage and Family Law (Elective) Offered during the Spring Semester.Law 33, Law and the Media (Elective) Offered during the Fall Semester.Law 35, Immigration Law for Paralegals (Elective) Offered during the Fall Semester.Law 37, Bankruptcy Law (Elective) Offered occasionally.Law 38, Criminal Law and Procedure (Elective) Offered occasionally.

The paralegal student must select and successfully complete a minimum of twenty-one (21) semester units in General Education (Plan B) in each of the following areas: see attached.

All course work must be completed with a grade of " C " or higher.

1. Demonstrate math competency using appropriate placement, as approved by the college or LACCD, one level higher than intermediate algebra (e.g., university transferable math courses); or
2. Submit official transcripts that a math course is equivalent to intermediate algebra or higher and was completed with a grade of "C" or better at a regionally accredited college; submit official external exams with a satisfactory score (e.g., AP, IB, CLEP); or
3. Complete one of the following LACC math courses with a grade of " C " or better:
